Subject of the Sentence

Auxiliary Verb
Avoir or Être

Past participle
(agreement for *être* verbs)

I	Je	ai	suis	regardé
You	Tu	as	es	vu
	Il / Elle / On He / She / You	a	est	allé(e)(s)
We	Nous	avons	sommes	pris
You	Vous	avez	êtes	bu
They	Ils / Elles	ont	sont	sorti(e)(s)



A night out with friends

- 1. **On** means ... **you, we**
- 2. **Avoir** and **être** are in the perfect tense. **auxiliary verbs**
- 3. **Past participles** have agreement ... **with être verbs**
- 4. **Ce n'était pas** = **it was not**
- 5. **Il est allé** = **he went**
- 6. **Hier** = **yesterday**
