







Je (I)	mange	ais used to eat
	choisis	 used to choose
Il / Elle / On (He/She/You)	fais	ait used to do
	écriv	 used to write
Ils / Elles (They)	mett	aient used to put
	pren	 used to take




Forming the imperfect tense with **être**

The verb **être** is the only **irregular verb** in the imperfect tense.
The stem is **ét**
