Main Task: Correct your answers.

crystallum ad terram cecidit. nunc milia fragmenta in terra iacebant.

Vedius iratus clamavit: 'mitte servum in piscinam!' servus a domino ad Augustum fugit. in terram ante imperatorem cecidit. servus ab imperatore petivit: 'eripe me a murenis!' Augustus de re putavit. tum imperator crystallum secundum tenuit et ad terram misit.
