Present tense -ar verbs

Remember that present tense verb endings change depending who the verb refers to.

Us**ar** = to use

Compare:

Us**o** Instagram

I use Instagram

Us**amos** Instagram

We use Instagram

To mean 'we' with an -ar verb, remove -ar and add -amos.

descarg- → descarg**amos** We download



Para

The word **para** has two meanings in Spanish.

Descargo canciones **para** mi madre.

=

I download songs for my mum.

Uso Spotify **para** descargar canciones.

=

I use Spotify **(in order) to** download songs.
