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Identify rational and irrational numbers

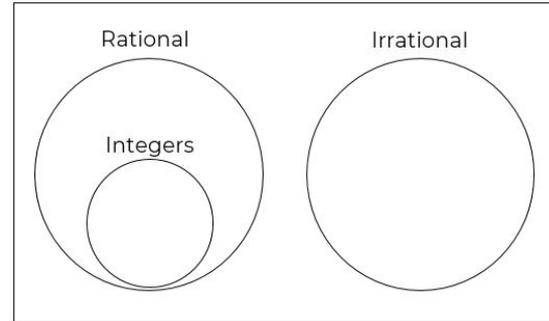
1. Sort the values into integers and non-integers.

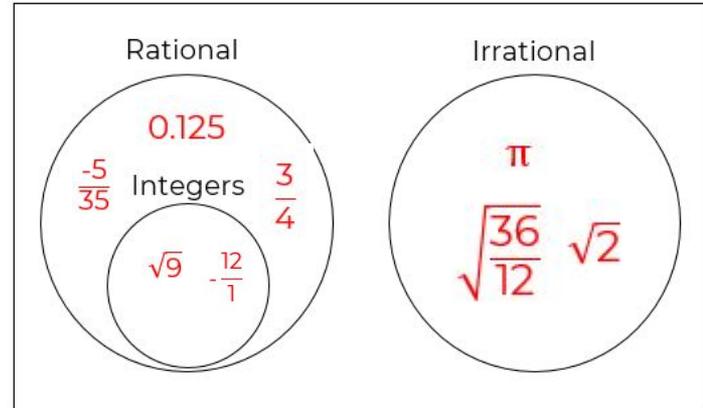
