





# Genitive prepositions - Summary

Some prepositions take the genitive case, which means they change the form of the article. They are: **außerhalb** - outside, **innerhalb** - inside, **statt** - instead of, **trotz** - despite, **während** - during, **wegen** - because of

|                  |                                   |                           |
|------------------|-----------------------------------|---------------------------|
| <b>masculine</b> | während <b>des Sommerurlaubs*</b> | during the summer holiday |
| <b>feminine</b>  | außerhalb <b>der Stadt</b>        | outside the town          |
| <b>neuter</b>    | wegen <b>des Wetters*</b>         | because of the weather    |
| <b>plural</b>    | trotz <b>der Touristen</b>        | despite the tourists      |

\*Masculine and neuter nouns end in -s or -es in the genitive case.



# Genitive prepositions

1. During the summer holiday =

**während der Sommerferien**

2. Despite the rain =

**trotz des Regens**

3. The hotel was inside the old town. =

**Das Hotel war innerhalb der Altstadt.**

4. Because of the lovely weather, we did lots of excursions.

**Wegen des schönsten Wetters haben wir viele Ausflüge gemacht.**
