Finger Family Finger Puppets



Do not make these finger puppets without an adult present for help and guidance.

This activity allows children to create their own finger family puppets. It can represent their own family or it can be used in an imaginative way. The puppets can be used alongside various voice-play singing games that have been covered in lessons 1-3, or with the song “Tommy Thumb”.

Finger Family



You will need....

- Scissors
- Sellotape
- Pencil or pen
- Colouring pens or pencils

- Thin card (optional)
- PVA glue or craft glue stick (optional)

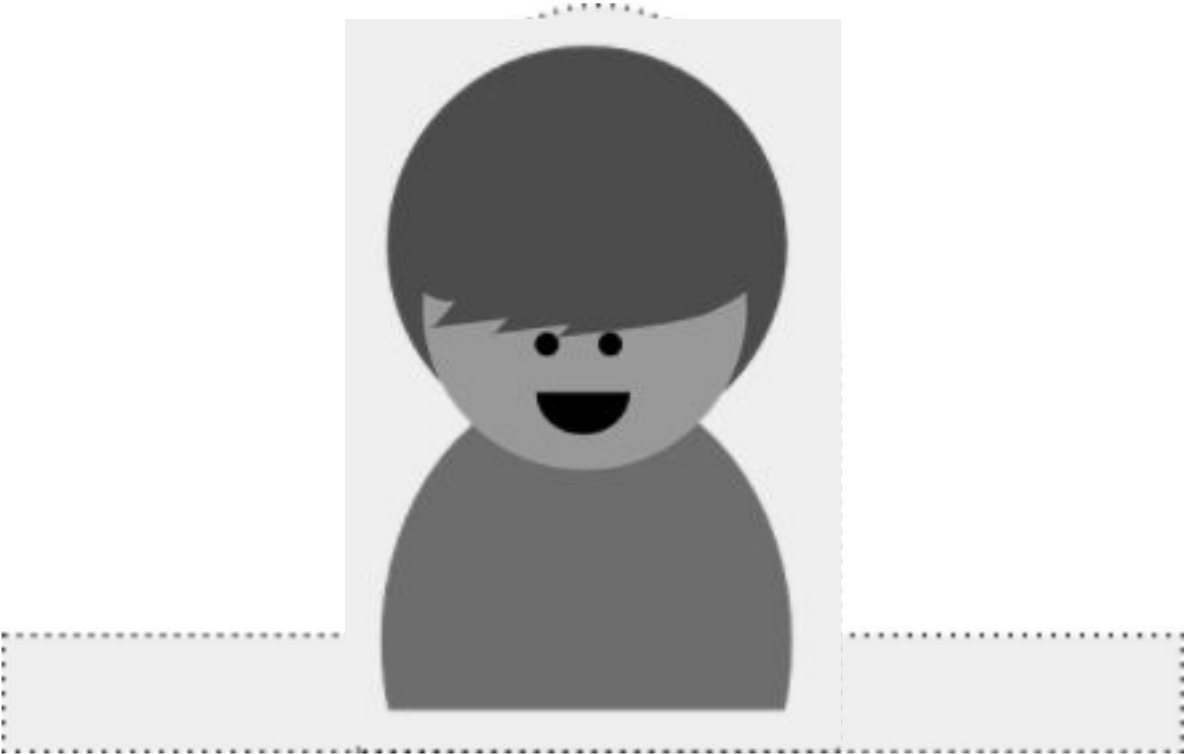


Instructions:

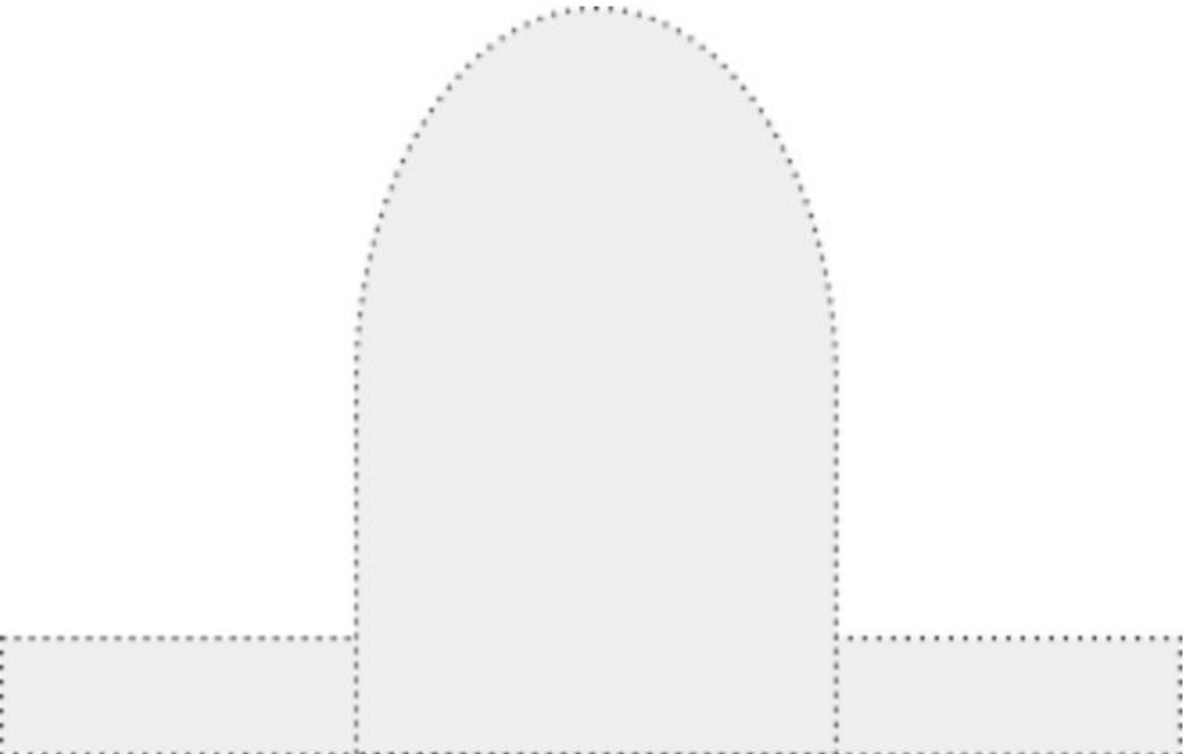
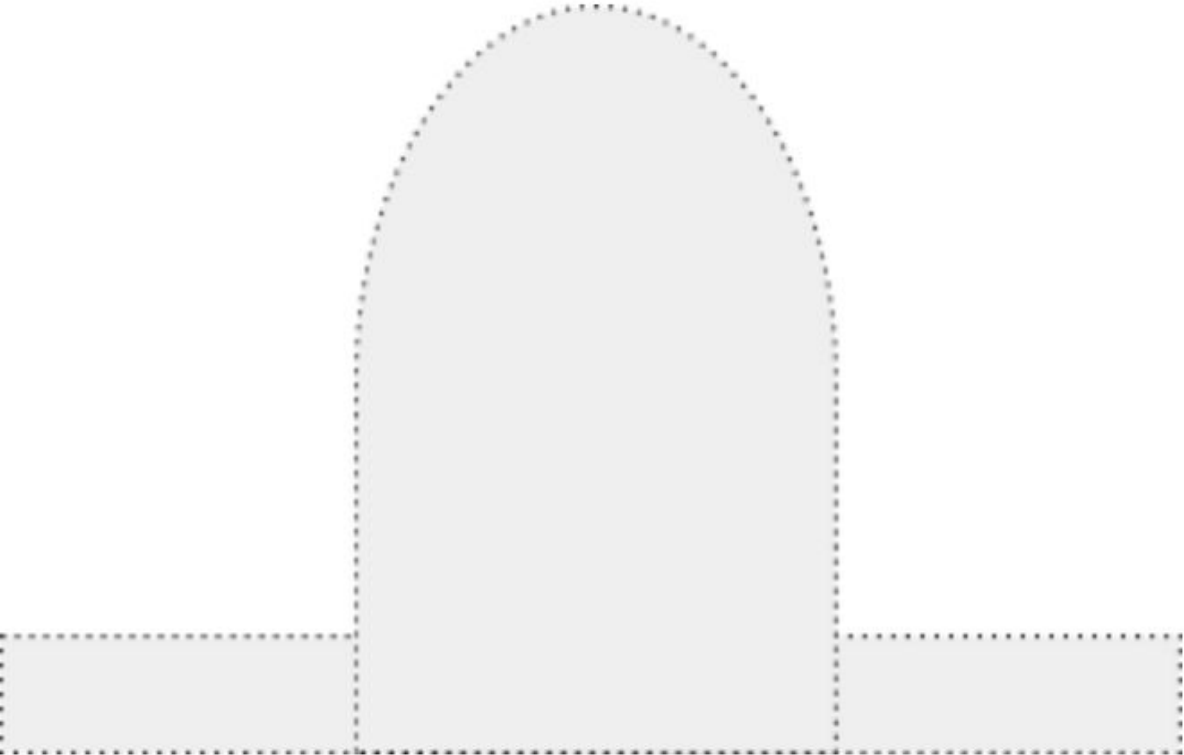
1. Create family characters on the blank templates or colour in the example templates
2. You can reinforce the puppets by sticking the templates onto thin card with a craft glue stick or PVA glue.
3. Ask an adult to help you cut out the puppet templates.
4. Measure the horizontal strips to your child's finger and sellotape the strip so it forms a ring shape to go over the fingers.



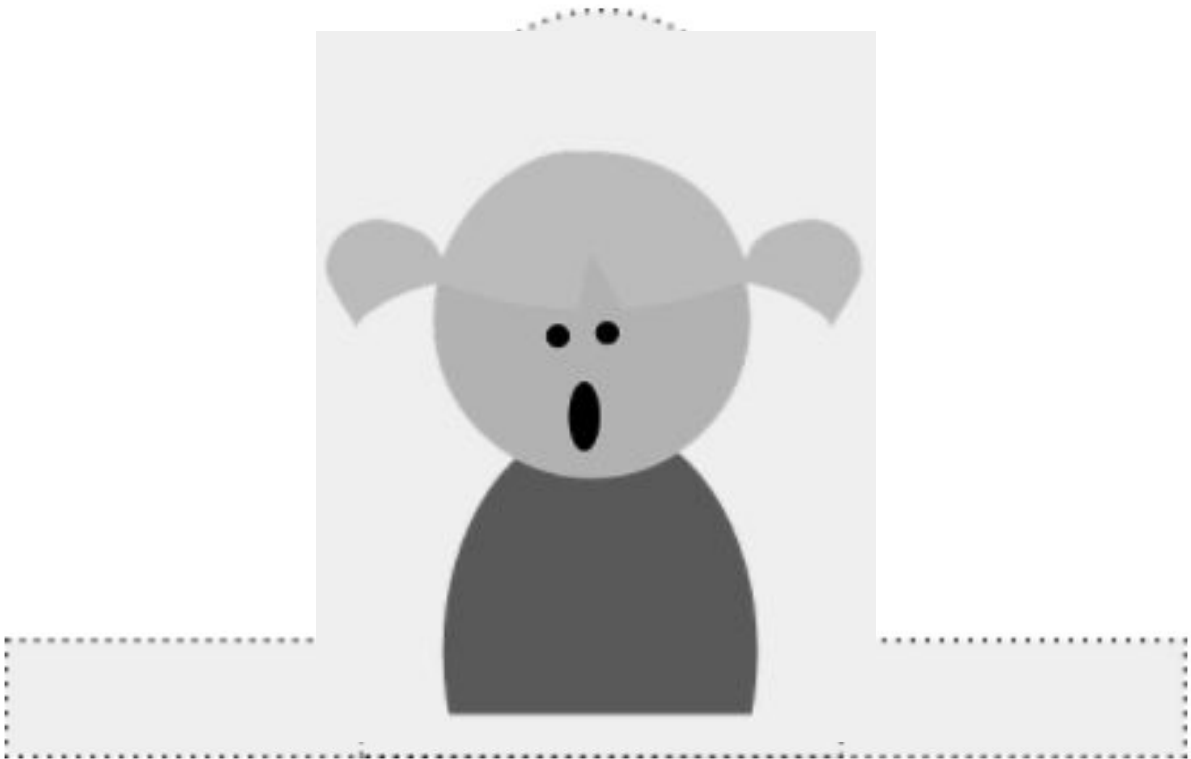
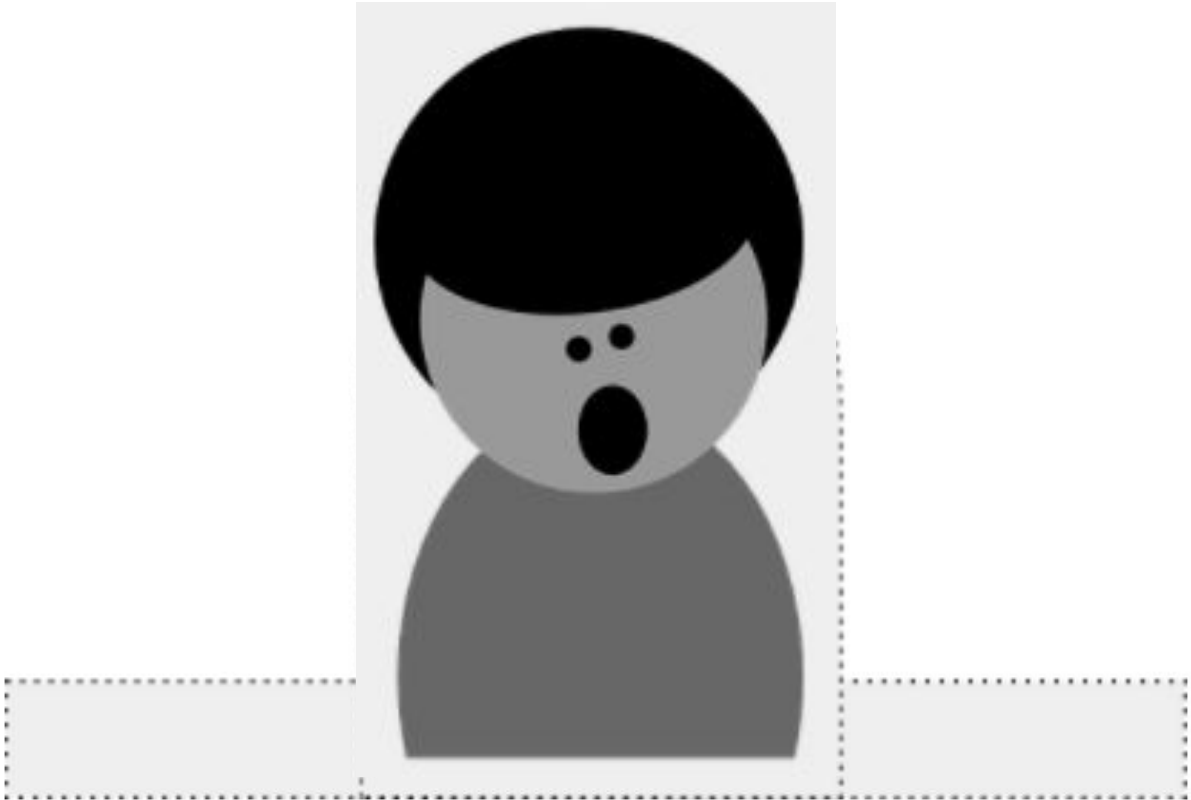
