

On Friday, 632 people visit Niagara Falls in the 632 morning. On Saturday morning, six times as many people visit. How many visited on Saturday morning? 3792 Keyrings are delivered to the Niagara Falls souvenir stand in packs of 4. The stand orders 407 boxes. How many keyrings have they 1628 ordered? It costs £119 to hire a car for the day. Isabelle hires a car for eight days. How much does she pay?



Question 2

Use column multiplication to solve each of the word problems.

749 A flight to Canada costs £749. Sally, Dani and Stephen fly together. What is the total cost of their trip? 315 An ice hockey player is paid £315. If they win, they are paid seven times as much. How much is the player paid when they win? 713 The Maid of the Mist boat carries six passengers in one trip. The boat does 713 trips in a day. How many passengers does it carry in one day?
