

Quick recap: playing the ground bass

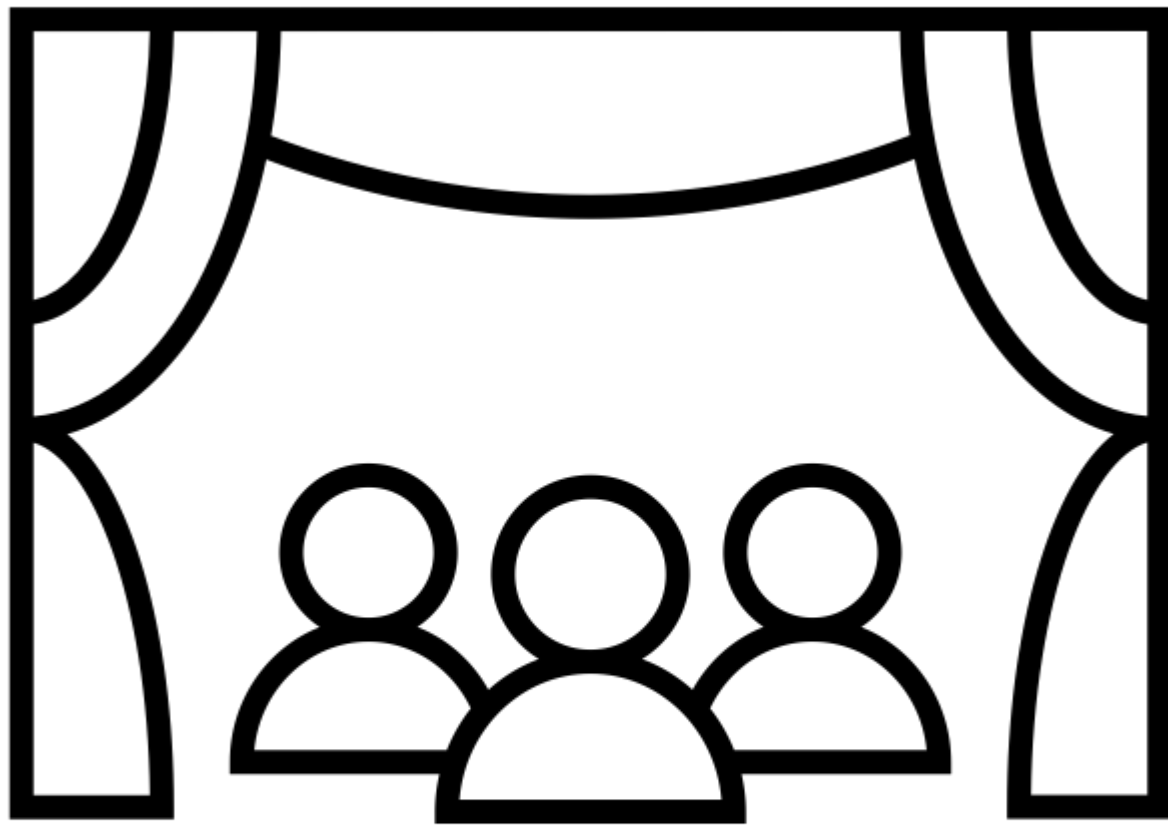

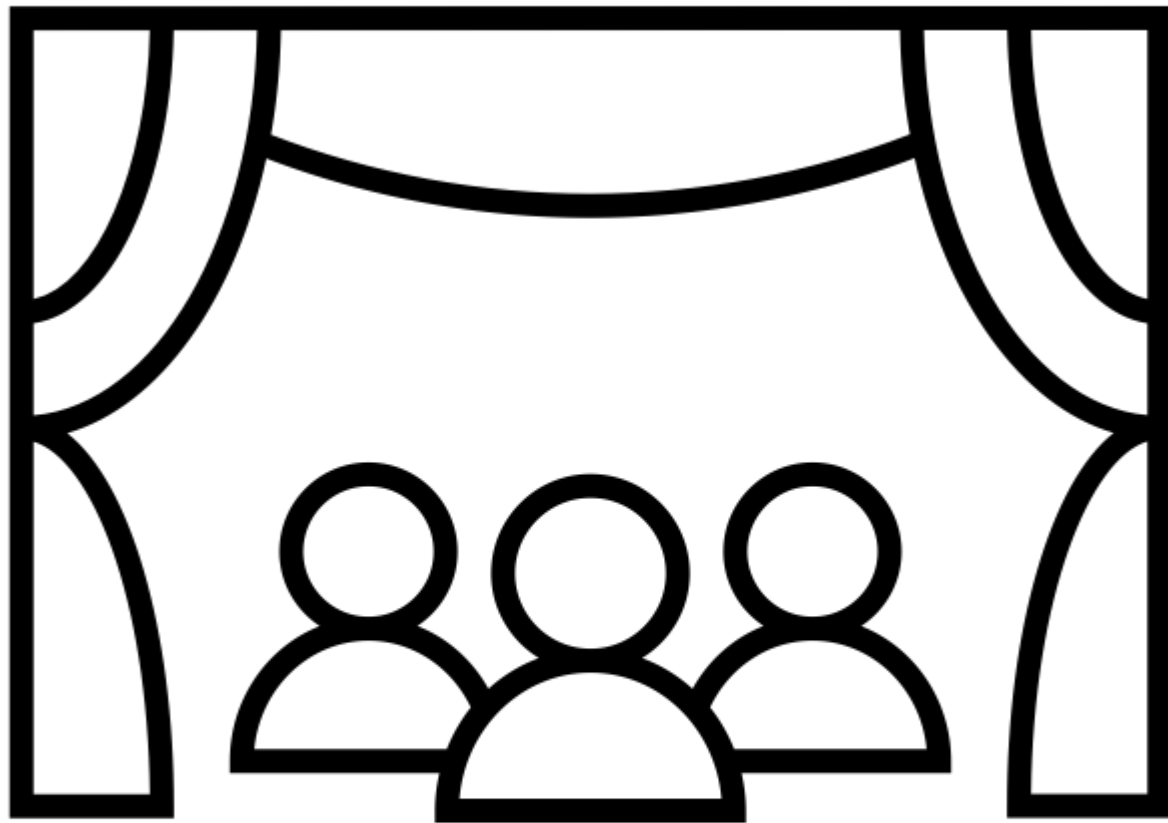
Your options:
