## Using the near future - we & they

To talk about **what we're going to do** we use the correct part of the verb '**ir**' ('**vamos**') followed by '**a**' and an <u>infinitive</u>. To talk about **what they're going to do** we use the correct part of the verb '**ir**' ('**van**') followed by '**a**' and an <u>infinitive.</u>

### Vamos a <u>llevar</u> ropa de calle.



We are going <u>to wear</u> non-uniform clothes.

#### Van a <u>comer</u> churros.



They are going to eat churros.

## Using idiomatic phrases with 'ir de'

We use '**ir**' followed by the preposition '**de**' in some idiomatic expressions.

ir de	compras	to go shopping
	paseo	to go for a walk
Remember to use the correct	visit	to visit
form of the verb (to go → ir ).	tapas	to go round the bars and have some tapas
	fiesta	to go out (night out/party)
