



Expressions with avoir




1. The verb 'avoir' is found in many French expressions.
2. Many of these expressions are idiomatic, we cannot translate them literally, so we must learn them.

J'ai faim	I am hungry
J'ai soif	I am thirsty
J'ai besoin de/d'	I need
J'ai envie de/d'	I want



Ordering in a restaurant



1. I am hungry =	J'ai faim
2. I am thirsty =	J'ai soif
3. I need =	J'ai besoin de
4. I want =	J'ai envie de
5. When does 'de' become 'd'?	When it precedes a vowel
