

infinitive	il / elle / on he / she / you (general)	ils / elles they
<b>écrire</b> to write/ writing	écrit	écrivent
<b>lire</b> to read / reading	lit	lisent
<b>mettre</b> to put / putting	met	mettent
<b>prendre</b> to take / taking	prend	prennent
<b>faire</b> to do / doing	fait	font




# Name vs pronoun as the subject of the sentence.

**il** écrit des messages.

= he writes messages

**Jean** écrit des messages.




il (he)

**elle** lit l'article.

= she writes messages

**Julie** lit l'article.



elle (she)



# Name vs pronoun as the subject of the sentence.

**ils** écrivent des messages.  
=they write messages

**Jean et Michel**



écrivent  
des messages.

**elles** lisent l'article.

=they read the article.

**Julie et Sophie**



lisent l'article.

elles (they fpl)
