Accusative	<i>me</i>	me	<i>te</i>	you (s)
Ablative	<i>me(cum)</i>	(with) me	<i>te(cum)</i>	(with) you (s)
Nominative	<i>nos</i>	we	<i>vos</i>	you (pl)
Accusative	<i>nos</i>	us	<i>vos</i>	you (pl)
Ablative	<i>nobis(cum)</i>	(with) us	<i>vobis(cum)</i>	(with) you (pl)



Possessive Adjectives

***meus, me-* = my**

***tuus, tu-* = your (s)**

<i>ego/me</i>	I/me	<i>tu/te</i>	you (s)
<i>nos</i>	we/us	<i>vos</i>	you (pl)

***noster, nostr-* = our**

***vester, vestr-* = your (pl)**
