## Lesson 4: Counting and Comparing groups

## Make it easier

When comparing who received more/less envelopes, make the difference obvious and clear.

Add dots underneath numerals to demonstrate their values on the envelopes and doors.

## Make it harder

Use different quantities of envelopes for different houses (so that the quantity does not match the numeral).

Begin to count on to 12 using the number names from lesson 2.

## More ideas

When your learner is counting, try asking them, how many if I add one more? How many if there is one less?

Help set the table - can your learner add more items to the place setting?
