




### **Present tense** -ar verbs: 1<sup>st</sup> person singular & plural (I / we)

### **Compare**:

nadar en el mar to swim / swimming in the sea. Nado en el mar. Swim in the sea.

To mean 'I' with -**ar** verbs, remove -ar and add -o.





This part of the verb is called the 'stem'.



# **Present tense** -ar verbs: 1<sup>st</sup> person singular & plural (I / we)



To mean 'we' with an –ar verb, remove –ar and add –amos to the stem.



### **Present tense** -ar verbs: 3rd person singular & plural (s/he, it / they)

## **Present tense: -ar verbs**

- 1. The verb ending for the 1st person singular ('*I*') is
- 2. 'Nadamos' means <u>We swim</u>
- 3. 'habla' means he speaks
- 4. <u>-a</u> is the ending for 3rd person singular (-ar verbs).
- 5. To mean 'they' with an -ar verb, we need to remove -ar and add <u>-an</u> to the stem.
