Use a bead string and a number line to solve each one!

The digit 3 in my number stands for 3 tens. The digit in the ones place is one less than 6.

The digit 4 in my number represents 4 tens. The number is less than 45. The digit in the ones place is one more than 2.

The value of the digit 3 in my number is three ones. My number is less than 15.

The digit 9 in my number stands for nine ones. My number is greater than 60. The digit in the tens place is one more than 7.




Independent Task - Answers

The digit 3 in my number stands for 3 tens. The digit in the ones place is one less than 6.


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
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
