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Using multiple tenses together

We use the presente sense to describe what things are

like or to say what usually happens.

Remember to use the correct verb ending to refer to a specific person and tense.

Es precioso.

It's beautiful.

Monto en bici.

I ride my

We use the **imperfect tense** to describe what something, someone or somewhere was like.

La gente **era** agradable.

People **were** nice.

Había un parque. There was a park.

We use the **preterite tense** to say what you did / what happened.

Viajé en avión.

I travelled by plane.

Aprendí sobre la cultura.

We went sightseeing.



Irregular verbs

Presente sense

Es precioso. **It's** beautiful.

Voy de paseo. **I go** for a walk.

Imperfect tense

La gente **era** agradable. People **were** nice.

Había un parque. There was a park.

Preterite tense


Fuimos a la playa. We went to the beach.

Hice turismo. I went sightseeing.

Ser and ir are
identical twins
in the preterite!
They have the
exact same form
(fuimos = we
went / we were
