Jokes - Knock Knock

Knock-Knock jokes are one of the best types of jokes you can learn.

A Knock Knock joke goes like this:

1. The teller says the **phrase 'Knock knock'**.
Knock Knock
2. The expectation is the other person says **'who is there?'**.
Who's there?
3. The teller then gives a **'name'**.
Lena
4. The other person says **'name +who'** as if asking for a surname.
Lena who?
5. The teller says something that **plays on the words** given as the 'name'

Rules for Jokes

Can you think of anymore?

Jokes should be **good-natured**.

This means they try and **avoid topics that might hurt someone else's feelings**.

If you are not sure if a joke might hurt someone's feelings you should **ask an adult** to 'check it'.

If someone doesn't laugh at the joke it might mean they didn't find it funny - and that's ok.

Jokes tend to be **funny once or twice** but you shouldn't repeat the same joke too many times with the same person.

If you don't understand a joke or why something is funny, **it is ok to ask**.

You could say... 'Can you explain that to me please?' or 'Can you tell me that again?'
