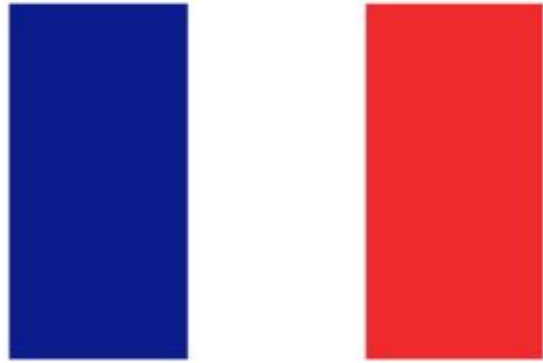

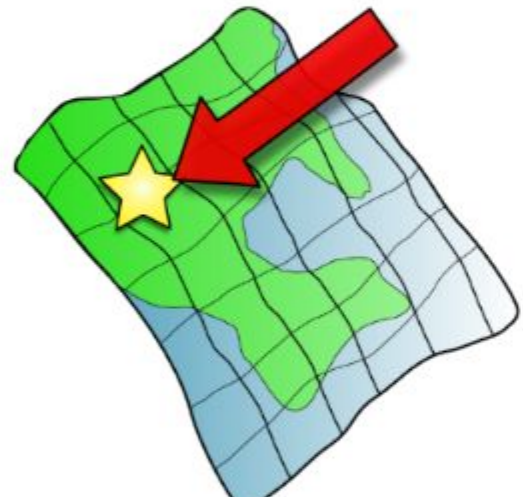

Definite articles

- In English we have the **definite** article the : **le** , **la** and **l'**

Masculine			
le	garçon	the	boy
l'	ami	the	friend

Feminine			
la	fille	the	girl
l'	amie	the	friend

In certain cases, you use **l'** or **l'**, before a noun when the first letter of a noun begins with a vowel or an h
