Saying ‘his’ or ‘her’ in French

The words for ‘his’ and ‘her’ are the same – we don’t know the possessor’s gender.



	his/her	English
Masculine noun	son frère	his/her brother
Feminine noun	sa soeur	his/her sister
M/F noun with vowel/h	son ami	his/her friend
Plural noun	ses enfants	his/her children



Saying ‘his’ or ‘her’ in French

It is **her** house

It is **his** house



C'est **sa** maison

It is **her** pen

It is **his** pen



C'est **son** stylo





Possessive adjectives - notre & nos

There are 2 words for 'our' in French: **notre** & **nos**

It only changes if the noun being described is singular or plural....

Before a
masculine
noun:

the
le

le frère



notre frère

Before a
feminine
noun:

the
la

la soeur



notre soeur



Possessive adjectives - notre & nos



There are 2 words for 'our' in French: **notre** & **nos**

It only changes if the noun being described is singular or plural....

Before a
noun with a
vowel / h:

the
'

' amie



notre amie

Before a
plural noun:

the
les

les parents



nos parents



Saying 'our' in French

The words for 'our' don't change depending on the possessor's gender.

	our	English
Masculine noun	notre frère	our brother
Feminine noun	notre soeur	our sister
M/F noun with vowel/h	notre ami	our friend
Plural noun	nos enfants	our children
