# The future tense


The future tense is used to say what **will** happen:

**Aprenderé** alemán.

**I will learn** German.

To form the future add a new ending to the **infinitive**:

**construir**



**construiré**

**I will build.**

All verb groups use the same set of endings

# Some verbs have an irregular stem in the future tense.

poner: **Pondré** la mesa.

I will lay the table

hacer: **Haré** mucho trabajo.

I will do lots of work.

saber: **Sabré** hablar otro idioma. I will know how to speak another language

poder: **Podré** viajar a Arequipa.

I will be able to travel to Arequipa.

Tener: **Tendré** muchos amigos.

I will have lots of friends.

All verb groups use the same set of endings



## I can + infinitive

### Puedo

Puedo **ir** a Venezuela.

I am able **to go** to Venezuela / I can go to Venezuela.

## If I can + future

### Si puedo

Si puedo, **iré** a Venezuela.

If I can, I **will go** to Venezuela.



# puedo / si puedo and future tense

1. Puedo means I can and is followed by an infinitive
2. Si puedo means if I can \_\_\_\_\_ and is followed by the future tense.
3. Future tense endings are added to the infinitive
4. The future tense ending for I is é \_\_\_\_\_
5. I will be able to is podré \_\_\_\_\_
