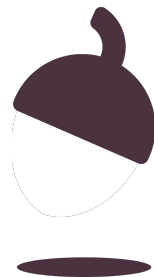

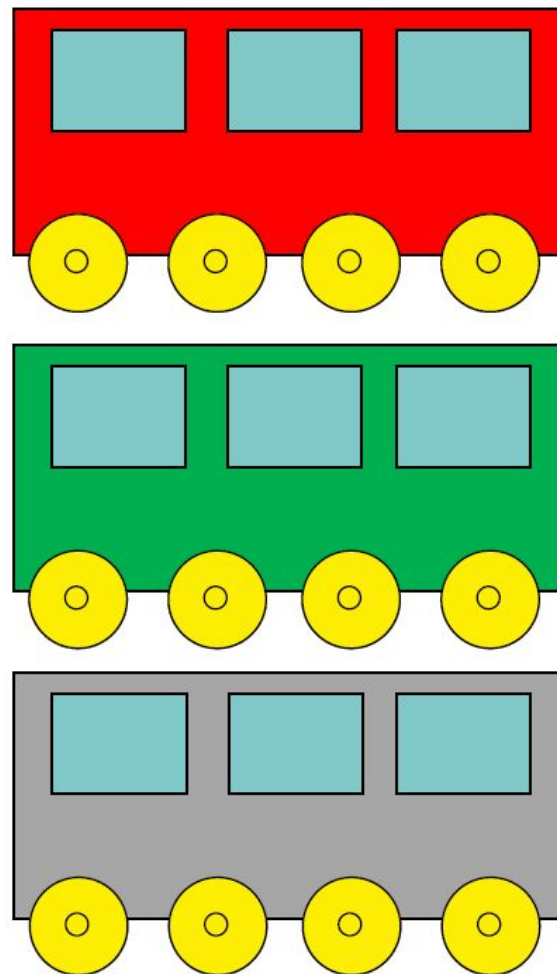

Can you work out how many passengers are in each carriage?

- There is 1 more passenger in the grey carriage than in the green carriage.
