Let's get started.




Online shopping

Turn on your device.

Find an internet browser, this could be google or Firefox.

Click the internet browser you would like to use.





Online shopping

You will see this screen. This is a search screen.

Now we need to type the name of the online shop.


Type the word: **amazon**

Now click enter and you will be taken to a list.

Double click on the online shop website.
