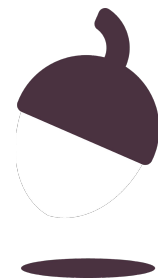

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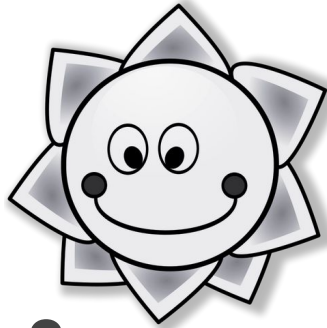

Present Tense - Common irregular -IR verbs

Dormir - To sleep



Je dors**s** - I sleep



Tu dors**s** - You sleep



Il/Elle dort**t** - He/she sleeps

Silent Final Consonant



Nous dorm**ons** - We sleep



Vous dorm**ez** - You (pl) sleep



Ils/Elles dorm**ent** - They sleep



Present Tense - Common irregular -IR verbs

partir and ***sortir*** follow a similar pattern to ***dormir***

Silent Final Consonant



Je dors**s** - I sleep

Je pars**s** - I leave

Je sors**s** - I go out



Il/Elle dort**t** - He/she
sleep

Il/Elle part**t** - He/she
leaves

Il/Elle sort**t** - He/she
goes out



Present Tense - Common irregular -IR verbs

Ven**ir** - To come



Je **viens** - I come



Tu **viens** - You come



Il/Elle **vient** - He/she comes



Nous ven**ons** - We come



Vous vene**ez** - You (pl) come



Ils/Elles **viennent** - They come

Present Tense - Common irregular -IR verbs

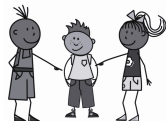
Revenir - To come **back**



Je **reviens** - I come **back**



Tu **reviens** - You come **back**



Il/Elle **revient** - He/she
comes **back**



Nous **revenons** - We come
back



Vous **revenez** - You (pl) come
back



Ils/Elles **reviennent** - They
come **back**

Present Tense - Common irregular -IR verbs

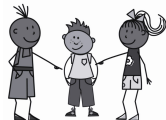
Devenir - To become



Je **deviens** - I **become**



Tu **deviens** - You **become**



Il/Elle **devient** - He/she
becomes

[SFC] Silent Final Consonant



Nous **devenons** - We **become**



Vous **devenez** - You (pl) **become**



Ils/Elles **deviennent** - They
become





Tu vs Vous

Tu is informal and singular, whereas **vous** is formal and/or plural.

The choice between the two pronouns defines the relationship between two people and how they interact.

tu



informal, singular

vous



formal and/or plural





Tu vs Vous with regular -er verbs

Tu is informal and singular, whereas **vous** is formal and/or plural. It also has an impact on **verb conjugations**.

Tu jou**es** = You play



(second person singular + stem +
es ending)

Vous jou**ez** = You play



(second person plural + stem +
ez ending)





Tu vs Vous

Tu is informal and singular, whereas **vous** is formal and/or plural.

The choice between the two pronouns defines the relationship between two people and how they interact.

	Informal	Formal
Singular	tu	vous
Plural	vous	vous





Tu vs Vous: please

Tu is informal and singular, whereas **vous** is formal and/or plural. It also has an impact on **how we say 'please.'**



S'il te plaît



(Si il te plaît)
informal, singular



S'il vous plaît



(Si il vous plaît)
formal and/or plural
