Weil and da

‘**Weil**’ and ‘**da**’ are subordinating conjunctions. This means they kick the **verb** to the end of the clause (similar to dass and obwohl).

‘**Weil**’ and ‘**da**’ mean ‘because’ and can be used in any tense.



, **weil/da** es schädlich **ist**.

, **weil/da** es schädlich **war**.

, **weil/da** es schädlich sein **wird**.

Remember
apply the
normal tense
rules and send
the **conjugated
verb** to the end!

Using weil/da:

1. **What does weil/da mean?** because
2. **What happens to the verb when you use weil/da?** verb is kicked to the end of the clause
3. **Can you name 2 other subordinating conjunctions?** dass / obwohl / wenn
4. **How do you say 'the best thing about it is'?** das Beste daran ist
5. **How do you say 'technology is my life, because I use it every day'.** Die Technologie ist mein Leben, da ich sie jeden Tag benutze!
