
# Using the conditional

1) Je voudrais être professeur




2) J'aimerais être professeur




# Using the conditional

1) **J'aimerais être professeur**



2) **Mon rêve serait d'être professeur**



# The Conditional Tense

Subject of the Sentence	The stem. This is the same as the future simple stem	Endings - the same as the imperfect endings
I - Je	Regular <b>ER</b> and <b>IR</b> verbs <b>Infinitive</b>	<b>ais</b>
You - Tu		<b>ais</b>
He / She / <b>You</b> - Il / Elle / <b>On</b>	Regular <b>RE</b> verbs <b>Infinitive minus E</b>	<b>ait</b>
We - Nous		<b>ions</b>
You - Vous	Some irregular verbs have irregular stems. <b>être = 'ser'</b>	<b>iez</b>
They - Ils / Elles		<b>aint</b>



# Travailler - to work, working (Regular verb)




Je travailler**ais** = I would work



Tu travailler**ais** = You would work



Il travailler**ait** = he would work



Elle travailler**ait** = she would work



On travailler**ait** = you / we would work



Nous travailler**ions** = we would work



Vous travailler**iez** = you would work



Ils travailler**aient** = they would work

Elles travailler**aient** = they would work



# Discussing career choices

1. We use the conditional to = Talk about what we would do
2. I would like = je voudrais/j'aimerais
3. He would like = Il voudrait/aimerait
4. My dream would be = Mon rêve serait
5. The verb ending ‘-ais’ corresponds with the pronoun = je/tu  
The verb ending ‘-ait’ corresponds with = il/elle, or singular nouns like ‘rêve’
