





# Is there a ...?

There are **two** possibilities when asking this question:



**Il y a** un restaurant? = Is there a restaurant?




**Est-ce qu'**il y a un magasin? = Is there a shop?



# Do you have ...?

There are **two** possibilities when asking this question:



**Vous avez** un dépliant? = Do you have a leaflet?



**Avez-vous** un plan de la ville? = Do you have a map of the town?

**Vous** - the polite/formal way of saying you.


Question words and Time



# Expressing time

There are **two** options of expressing time in French:

## 12 hour



**Il est dix heures dix** =  
It's 10 minutes past 10

## 24 hour



**Il est vingt heures dix-huit** =  
It is 18 minutes past 8



# Question words

Here are some question words:

**Combien?**

C'est **combien**? - How much is it?

**Quel?**

**Quel** est le prix? - What is the price?

**Où?**

**Où** sont les toilettes? - Where are the toilets?

**Quand?**

**Quand** commence le match? - When does the match start?

**Qu'est-ce que?**


**Qu'est-ce qu'**on va faire? - When are we going to do?

**Comment?**

C'est **comment**? - What is it like?



# Discussing what to see and do



1. ***Est-ce que*** goes at the start of a question.
2. ***Avez-vous*** means the same as *Vous avez*
3. The opposite of *ouvert* is *fermé*
4. Who might get a price reduction? *jeunes/étudiants*
5. Translate free (of charge) = *gratuit*
6. Translate ***C'est combien?*** = How much is it?
