


Challenge: Exchanging money for goods

Role play

In your 'shop' can you count the correct amount of coins (up to 9x 1p coins) to exchange for your item.

Mix and match the price cards so that children practise different costs/counting

Lesson 2: Exchanging appropriate quantities for an item.

Make it easier

Use smaller quantities of coins. You may also wish to use a pictorial structure such as a number line to help count out the coins in exchange for an item.

Make it harder

Begin to discuss and introduce the concept of coins with different values. It is not necessary that children understand this at this stage, but this builds on their current understanding.

More ideas

Apply this in a real life setting, encouraging children to exchange coins for items in a market place. *Only do this where it is safe to do so, taking precautions to limit the exposure to germs.*
