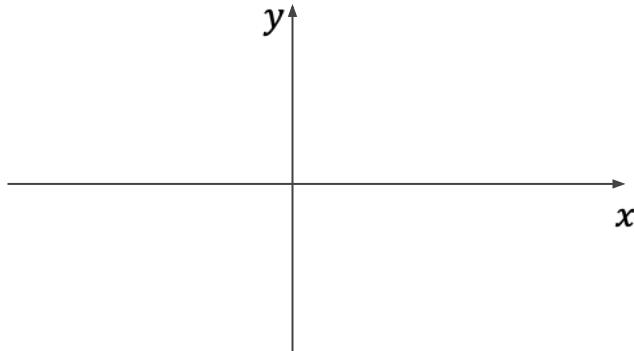
Sketch graphs of simple cubic functions

c) Sketch the graph.

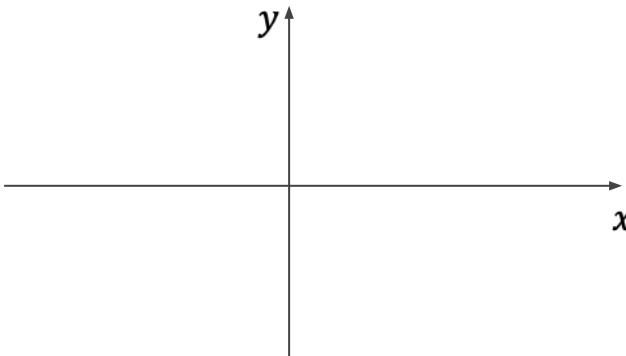


2. For $y = (x - 1)(x - 3)(x + 2)$

c) Sketch the graph.



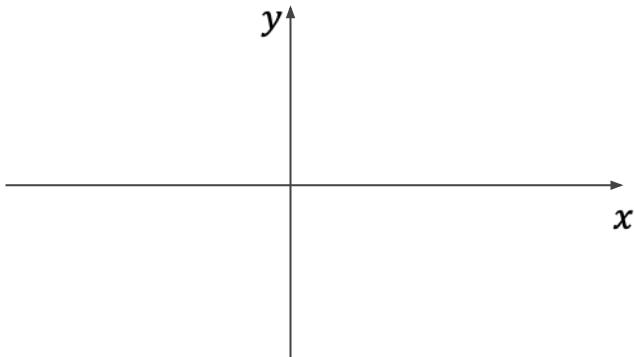

a) Find the x-intercepts using $y = 0$

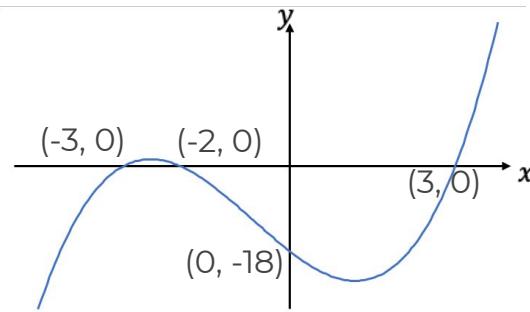
b) Find the y-intercept using $x = 0$

c) Sketch the graph.

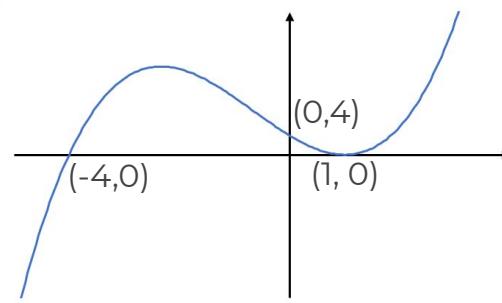


4. Write the functions shown in the form $y = (x + a)(x + b)(x + c)$.

Sketch graphs of simple cubic functions

1. For $y = (x + 1)(x + 4)(x - 2)$

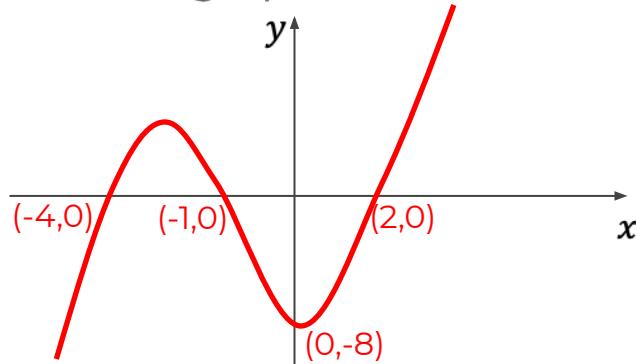
a) Find the x-intercepts using $y = 0$

2. For $y = (x - 1)(x - 3)(x + 2)$

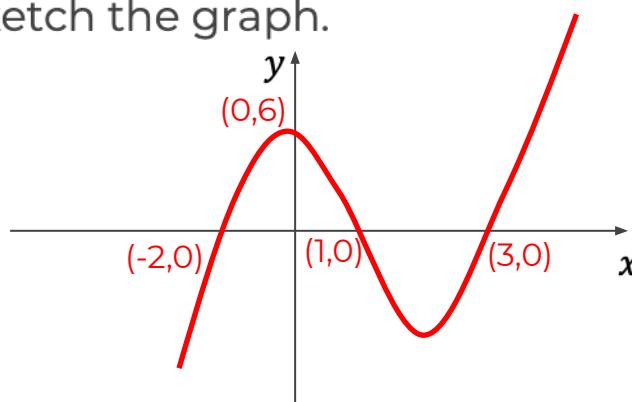
a) Find the x-intercepts using $y = 0$

3. For $y = (x + 3)^2(x - 2)$

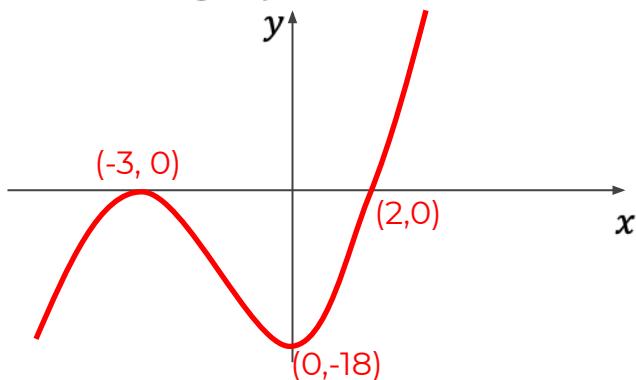
a) Find the x-intercepts using $y = 0$

b) Find the y-intercept using $x = 0$

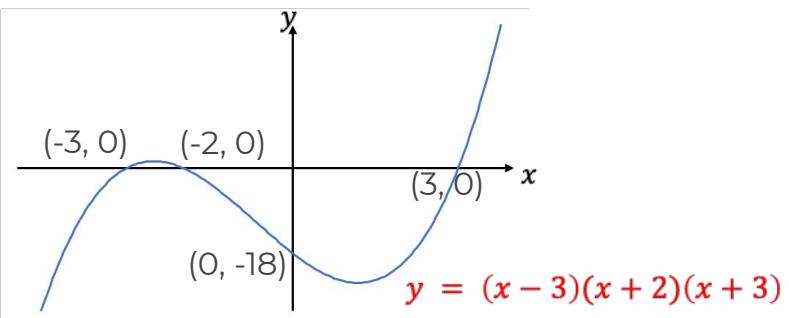
$$y = -18$$
