#### manger - to eat / eating (regular verb)

**Jemange** = | eat



first person

On mange = You/We eat







#### grignoter - to snack / snacking (regular verb)

Je grignote = I snack



first person

**On** grignote = You/We snack







#### prendre - to take / taking (irregular verb)

Je prends = I take



first person

**On** prend = You/We take







#### boire - to drink / drinking (irregular verb)

Je bois = I drink



first person

On boit = You/We drink







### Regular -ER verbs and irregular -RE verbs for the 1st person VS 3rd person singular.
