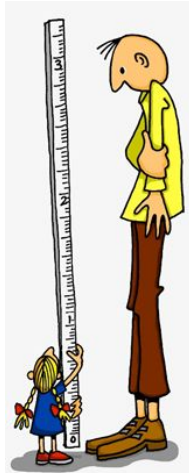

Sie - what does it mean and when do you use it?

Sie means you and is used in formal situations and for people (either one person OR a group of people) you do not know.

Sie trink**en**

You drink

Sie werd**en** trinken

You will drink

Sie hab**en** getrunken

You drank

Sie würd**en** trinken

You would drink

Sie möcht**en** trinken

You would like to drink

What is the conjugated verb ending for Sie?

How do you
make a question
now?

To make a question simply switch
the **verb** and the **pronoun** around.....

Sie trinken
Sie werden trinken
Sie haben getrunken
Sie würden trinken
Sie möchten trinken

Trinken Sie?

Werden Sie trinken?

Haben Sie getrunken?

Würden Sie trinken?

Möchten Sie trinken?

Are you drinking?

Will you drink?

Did you drink?

Would you drink?

Would you like to drink?



Sie

When writing, it is important to remember to write Sie with a **capital**. Why??

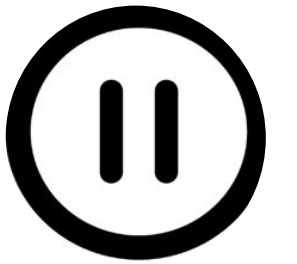
It is easy to confuse **Sie** (you, formal) with **sie** (they) when writing as the verb endings are the same!!

Normalerweise essen **sie** Gemüse.
Normally **they** eat vegetables.

Normalerweise essen **Sie** Gemüse.
Normally **you** eat vegetables.



Using the pronoun Sie:



1. How do you say you for a person or people you do not know? **Sie**
2. What is the conjugated verb ending for this pronoun? **EN**
3. Why is it important to remember a capital when writing this pronouns? **without a capital it can be confused with 'they'**
4. How do you form a simple question?
switch the pronoun and the verb around
5. How do you say 'would you (formal) like to order dessert?'
