#### gern, lieber, am liebsten - A Recap

gern = gladly



lieber = rather



am liebsten = the best / most





#### Word order in German sentences

As you probably already know, the order of words in a simple German sentence is:

Subject	Verb	Adverb	Object
ich	downloade	(nicht) gern	Popmusik



#### Word order in German sentences

Notice that when you say which instrument you play, you don't use the article 'the' in German

The position of adverbs is different in English! **Time adverbs** are often the **last** idea in the sentence.

Subject	Verb	Adverb	Object
ich	downloade	jeden	Popmusik
