





der Maitag	May day
der Karneval	Karneval (specific to north Germany)
das Opferfest	Eid al-Adha
das Chanukah	Chanukah
das Fest	party/celebration





Using a range of tenses

Perfect:

Ich **habe** Schokolade **gegessen.**

Don't forget you need a form of **haben/sein** and a **past participle** at the end of the sentence. Remember regular past participles add a 'ge' and end in 't' and irregular often end in 'en'

Present:

Ich feiere**e** gern Karneval.

Look at the pronoun to identify the verb endings: **-e, -st, -t, -en, -t, -en.**

Future:

Ich **werde** Zeit mit Familie **verbringen.**

Don't forget you need the present tense of '**werden**' and an **infinitive** at the end of the sentence:
ich werde
er/sie wird
wir werden



Using a range of tenses:

1. What do you need for the perfect tense?

form of haben/sein and a past participle

2. What are the verb endings in the present?

e, st, t, en, t, en

3. What do you need for the future tense?

form of werden and an infinitive

4. How do you say: I like celebrating Christmas

Ich feiere gern Weihnachten

5. How do you say: I will celebrate New Year's Eve with friends.

Ich werde Silvester mit Freunden feiern
