



The conditional

The conditional is used to say what you would/could/should do. It allows you to express your hopes and dreams.

Today we will be looking at 2 structures which both mean would like and both need an infinitive at the END of the sentence.





Can you figure out which words mean 'would like'? What are the infinitives?



Just a reminder.....

Infinitives end in en, this is how you would find the word in the dictionary.

For example: kaufen - to buy essen - to eat



Can you think of any other infinitives for the topic area of food?
