2. Add the correct ending.




Rigoler - To laugh




**Je rigole** - I laugh




**Tu rigoles** - You laugh

**Nous rigolons** - We laugh



Rigoler - To laugh


**Je** rigole = I laugh

**Je** rigole = I laugh


