

To refer to one **specific** person or someone you know well (informal)



Vous

To refer to a group of **specific** people or à person or people you do not know (*formal*)



Nous = we

To refer to a group of **specific** people including you



On = You, we

To refer to people in **general**



The pronoun on



We use on when talking about people in general.

We can translate it is 'people', 'you', or 'one'

It uses the il/elle verb endings.

We can also use 'on' to mean 'we' in an informal situation, such as talking to a friend:

On parle anglais en Écosse

We speak/are speaking English in Scotland
