ces chaussures



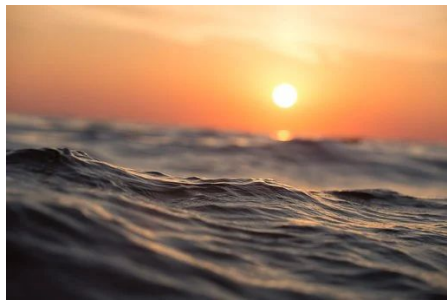
= **these** shoes





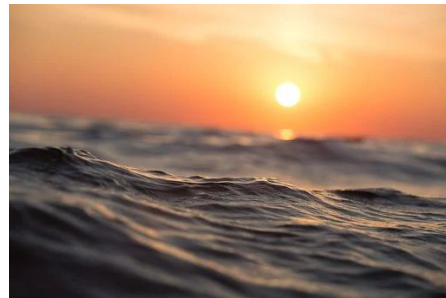
Demonstrative adjectives

l'été



= the summer

cet été



= **this** summer





Demonstrative adjectives - this or that

Demonstrative adjectives are used to point out a **specific thing** or **person** or to **emphasise** something.

They come **before a noun** and **agree with the noun**.

	Singular	Plural
Masculine	ce	ces
Feminine	cette	ces

Ce changes to **cet** before a masculine singular noun that begins with a **vowel** or a **silent -h**

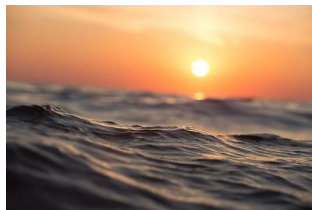
