

Good to be Me: Music Activity

Voiceplay

This music activity helps you to play with your voice and use your imagination to create lots of different characters with different voices.



You will need....

- Pencils or felt tip pens to draw your characters
- A piece of blank paper




Instructions:

1. Use your blank piece of paper or the printout on slide 5 and 6 of the worksheet to draw some characters that you imagined with your singing spoon today.
2. Think about whether their voice was high or low, loud or soft?
3. What do your characters look like, what colour are they and what texture are they? How big or small are they?
4. You might like to also draw a picture of yourself hiding in the cupboard, playing hide and seek with your imaginary characters.
