




Je **ne** parle **pas**

Je **ne** écoute **pas**




Je **n'** écoute **pas**

ne changes to **n'** before a verb starting with a vowel.




[*You are going*]

Tu **ne** vas **pas**


[*You are not going*]



faire



Express future intention [2 / 2]



1. I am going to play = **Je vais jouer**
2. I am not going to play = **Je ne vais pas jouer**
3. We are going to watch = **Nous allons regarder**
4. We are not going to watch = **Nous n'allons pas regarder**
5. She is going to leave = **Elle va partir**
6. She is not going to leave = **Elle ne va pas partir**
