Here are some question words:

Combien?

C'est **combien**? - How much is it?

Quel?

Quel est le prix? - What is the price?

Où?

Où sont les toilettes? - Where are the toilets?

Quand?

Quand commence le match? - When does the match start?

Qu'est-ce que?

Qu'est-ce qu'on va faire? - What are we going to do?

Comment?

C'est **comment**? - What is it like?

Using *quel*

Here are some examples of using *quel* correctly:

Quel bateau? (m.)

What boat?

Quelle rue? (f.)

What road?

Quels restaurants? (m. pl.)

What restaurants?

Quelles boîtes de nuit? (f. pl.)

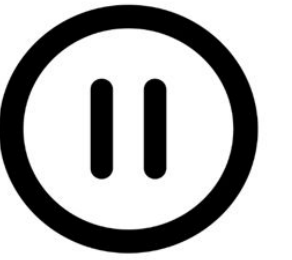
What nightclubs?

REMINDER - the key points to consider:

- *Quel* must agree with the noun, it works like an adjective;
- *Quel* translates as what and can also mean which.



Discussing what to see and do



1. ***Quel*** works like an adjective
2. ***Quel*** translates as what or which
3. ***Les heures d'ouverture*** = opening times/hours
4. ***La plan de la ville*** = town map
5. ***Louer*** = to hire
6. ***La durée*** = duration
