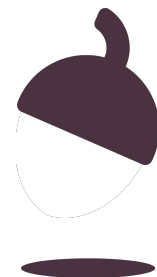

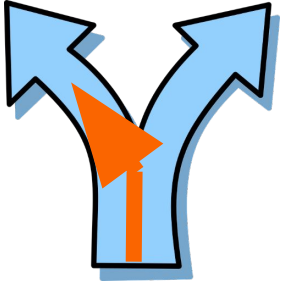

2. If I were rich =	Si j'étais riche
3. The conditional tense ending for the 'je' form is...	ais
4. The conditional tense ending for the 'on' form is...	ait
5. This would be =	Ce serait
