3. Explain what you think they show about Grendel's character.



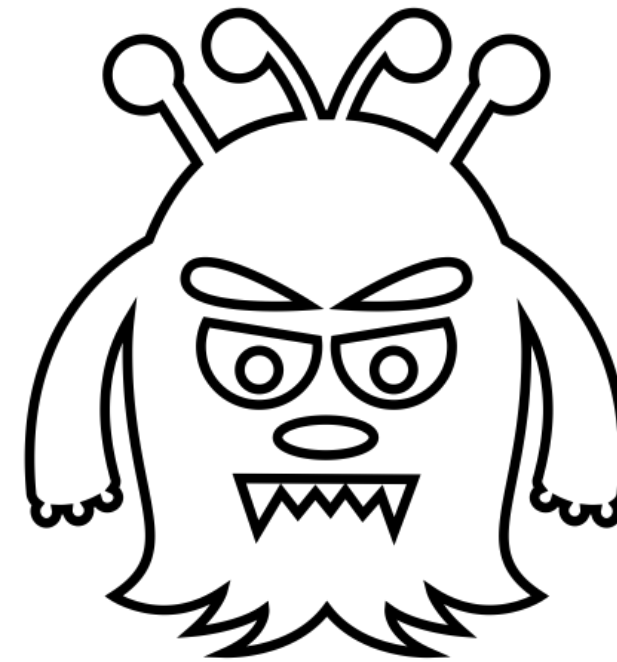
