





- In English, the indefinite article is **a**.
- In French, there are three indefinite articles **un / une / des**.

	Masculine	Feminine	Plural
Indefinite	un	une	des

Il y a **une** plage



Il y a **un** village



Il y a **des** champs



Il y a is followed by a word to show
how many items there are.

This is likely to be **un / une / des**
