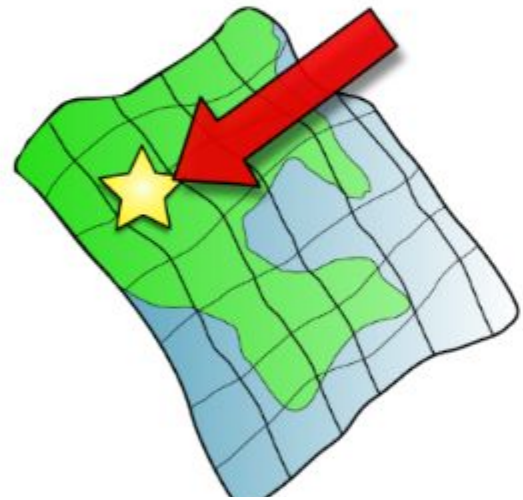

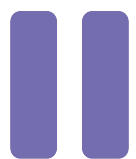

- In English, the indefinite article is **a**.
- In French, there are three indefinite articles **un** / **une** / **des**.

	Masculine	Feminine	Plural
Indefinite	un ✓	une ✓	des ✓



Il y a - There is or there are



Il y a une plage



Il y a un village



Il y a des champs



Il y a is followed by a word to show **how many** items there are.

This is likely to be un / une / des
