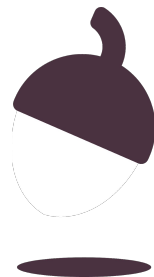

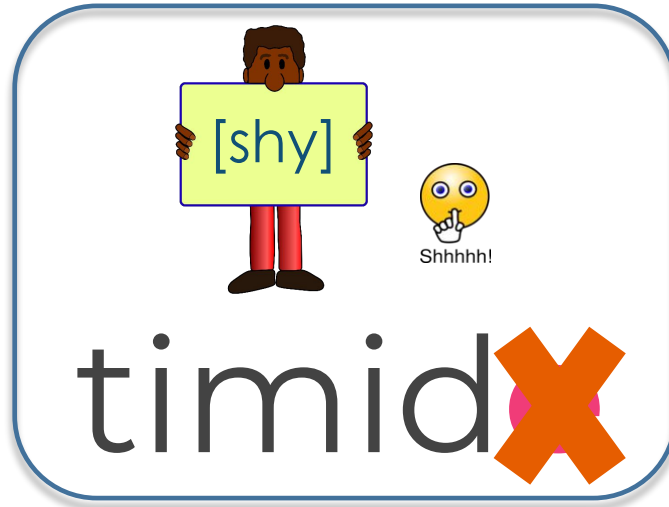

m'installer avec mon copain/ma copine	to move in with my boy/girlfriend

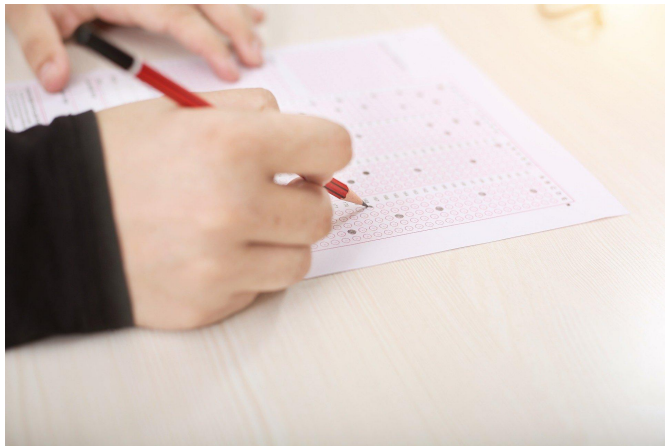


Remember,

Example:
faire = to
do/doing



Using the simple future - er and ir verbs

Je passerai mes examens



Je réussirai mes examens



Using the simple future - reflexive verbs

Je **me** marierai



Je **me** pacserai



Using the simple future - irregular verbs

Je **ferai** du bénévolat



J'**aurai** des enfants



The simple future verb ending for the pronoun 'je' = -ai

Verbs with **regular** future stems

passer
continuer

Verbs with **irregular** future stems

avoir = aur
être = ser
faire = fer
aller = ir

irregular
verbs have
irregular
stems.

Talking about future plans

1. For regular -er/-ir verbs, the future stem is = the infinitive
2. To make the stem for regular -re verbs, we need to remove = the 'e' from the infinitive.
3. The simple future ending for 'je' = ai
4. The future stem of avoir = aur
5. The future stem of faire = fer
6. I will sit my exams = Je passerai mes examens.
7. I will pass my exams = Je réussirai mes examens.
