Adjective agreement

Remember that adjectives match the noun they refer to, in **gender** and **number**:

Tienen **un** director. Es nervioso. *They have a head teacher. He is nervous.*

Tienen **unos** profesores. Son buenos. *They have some teachers. They are good.*

Tienen **una** prima. Es alta. *They have a (female) cousin. She is tall.*

Tienen **unas** vistas. Son hermosas. *They have some views. They are beautiful.*
