<b>Keyword</b>	<b>Definition</b>
	When glaciers move material (sand, clay, rock) across large distances. This happens at the base of the glacier, inside the glacier and on top of the glacier.
	When material being transported (carried) by the glacier is dropped. This happens when the glacier retreats.
	When a glacier begins to melt and shrinks in size.
	A type of deposit found in areas that previously had glaciers. It is soft, has a clayey texture, is easily eroded and made up of randomly sized rocks.
