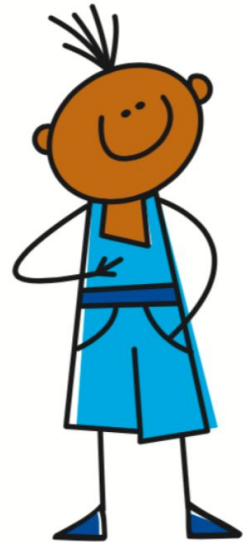

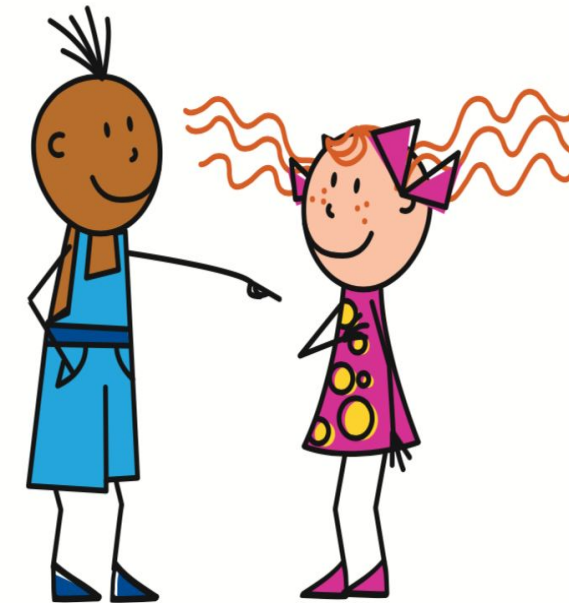


J'achète = I buy

Acheter - to buy

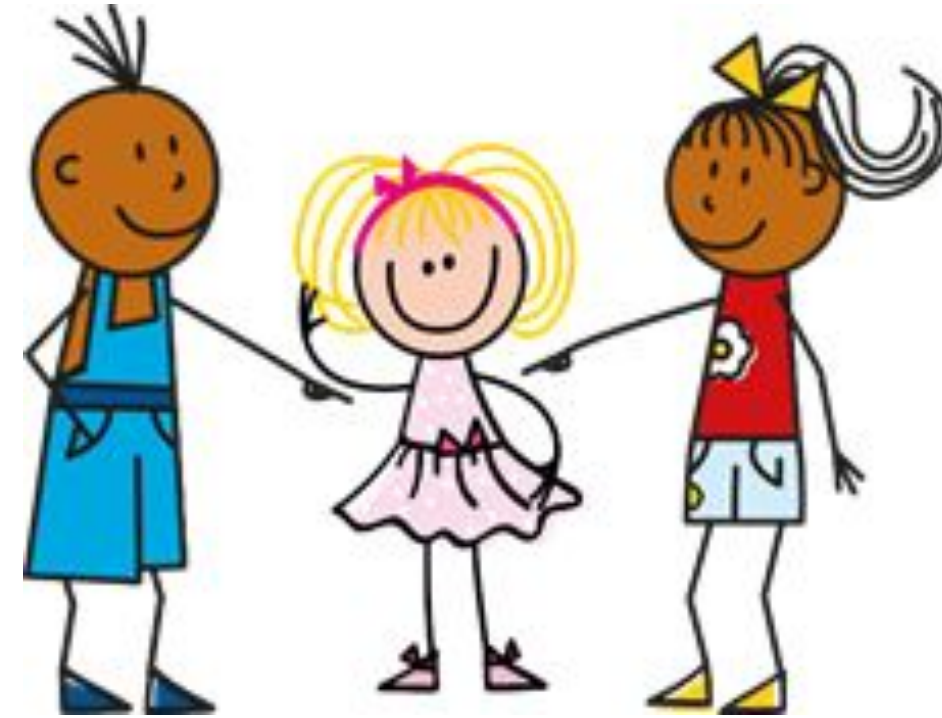


Il achète = He buys

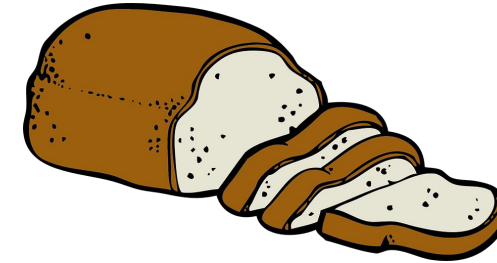

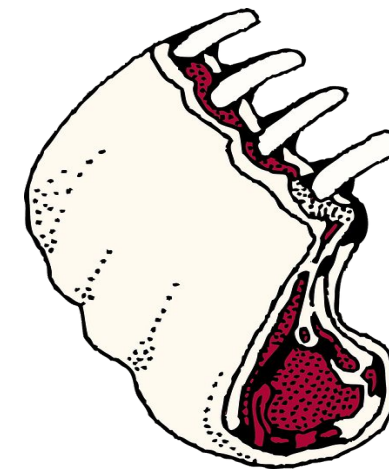
