

Prendre: to take



These verb forms all sound the same!
The **-s** on the *je* and *tu* forms is a
silent final consonant (SFC)

je prends

I take / I am taking

tu prends

you take / you are taking

il prend

he takes / he is taking

elle prend

she takes / she is taking



Apprendre: **to learn**



Before the **vowel (a)**,
je becomes **j'**
(like in 'j'aime')

j'apprends

I learn / I am learning

il apprend

he learns / he is learning

tu apprends

you learn / you are learning

elle apprend

she learns / she is learning



Comprendre: **to understand**



je comprends

I understand / I am
understanding

tu comprends

you understand / you are
understanding

il comprend

he understands / he is
understanding

elle comprend

she understands / she is
understanding



Dire: **to say**



je dis

I say/I am saying

tu dis

you say / you are saying

il dit

he says/ he is saying

elle dit

she says/ she is saying
