



# Using subject pronouns: nosotros/as ('we') & ellos/as ('they') & **hacer**

In Spanish, remember the verb (or its ending) tells us **who** it refers to.

Here is an example with the verb *hacer* (to do/make):

Hac**emos** = **we do / make**.

Hac**en** = **They do / make**.

**When comparing different people**, Spanish uses a subject pronoun (e.g. I, you, he) before the verb. This makes it clear who the verb refers to.

**Nosotros** hac**emos** la comida, mientras que **ellos** no haces tareas.

**We** make the food, whereas **they** don't do tasks.

So, '**nosotros**' means '**we**' and '**ellos**' means '**they**'.






# Using subject pronouns: nosotros, nosotras ('we') & ellos, ellas ('they')

To say 'he', use : él. To say 'she', use ella.


To say 'we', use **nosotros** for an all male / mixed group. 1




Use **nosotras** for an all female group. 2




To say 'they', use **ellos** for an all male / mixed group. 3



Use **ellas** for an all female group. 4



# Using 'hacer' to talk about the weather



We use the **3rd person singular** of the verb **hacer** to talk about the weather.

Note that 'hace' is always followed by a noun

- |             |         |                    |
|-------------|---------|--------------------|
| <b>Hace</b> | sol.    | <i>It's sunny.</i> |
| <b>Hace</b> | viento. | <i>It's windy.</i> |
| <b>Hace</b> | calor.  | <i>It's hot.</i>   |
